MATHIS is a plot wine, it is the essence of the best plot of the winery. It is obtained from two plots on the same hill: El Cerezo and Los Cerezos, the oldest vineyards of the winery being a pre-phylloxera part.

TERROIR

soil Soil formed in the Miocene, mainly limestone, reddish sandy clays and clayey loams, all plots are located between 850 and 890 meters above sea level.

vineyard The grapes come from two vineyards, El Cerezo and Los Cerezos. All our vineyards are planted in goblet as is traditional. They were planted in 1895 and 1945 (70 and 120 years old). The average yield obtained is 750 Kg/Ha.

harvest 2014 Year without adverse weather conditions. Hot summer, but not too hot, which allowed for complete ripening and harvesting of each plot at the optimum point. Productive year.

WINE MAKING

viticulture The care of the vineyard is organic in the process of certification.
The harvest is carried out in 15 kg boxes manually.
Double selection in the vineyard and on the sorting table.
Harvest date: September 19.

winery process Gravity winemaking. Destemming without crushing in order to maintain the integrity of the berries. Fermentation is carried out in stainless steel tanks of small volume. Native yeasts are used. FML in French oak barrels. Aged for more than 18 months in new and used French oak barrels and 225 l. 75cl and Magnum bottles.

TASTING NOTES

sight Garnet red, dark, clear and bright with a high layer.

scent Intense and elegant on the nose, with notes of black fruits and spices such as licorice.

taste In the mouth it shows its elegance and nuances. Fresh and balanced, with well integrated wood. Velvety tannins, with a combination of toasted notes that give it depth. A wine with great personality.
